MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: MKULTRA - George White

1. In our search for [redacted], we asked the Social Security Administration to help us find [redacted], who had been present when [redacted] was apparently dosed. The SSA sent [redacted] a letter offering him the opportunity to call or write us. On 20 July 1979, [redacted] called (collect, so we had suggested). I said our first order of business was to establish whether he was the [redacted] we were looking for. I asked him if he knew George and [redacted] White, and he said he guessed he was the one we were looking for. I then explained that we were looking for people whom we thought might have been given LSD without their knowledge or consent, making it quite clear that he was not thought to have been a subject, but probably was present when someone else was given a dose.

2. [redacted] did not remember the names or persons present at White's home on 9/12/53. He did not know [redacted] but seemed to recall that "such a person existed." He remembered a party at White's where there was conversation about LSD but couldn't recall specifics. When I read to him the 9/12/53 entry from the diary, he remembered an incident involving a woman but had "passed her off as some kook" and wondered, "Geez, where did George pick this one up."

3. [redacted] seemed to think that [redacted] might have been given LSD at White's home, or have been present when someone else was. [redacted] had seen an [redacted] at one time when [redacted] were employed at [redacted]. [redacted] called [redacted] not long ago and told [redacted] he was planning to retire from his business in the [redacted] and establish residence [redacted] some time this summer.

SUBJECT: MKULTRA - George White

When they talked, [REDACTED] said he would see [REDACTED] in August. [REDACTED] volunteered to ask [REDACTED] to call us if he has any information that he feels would be of value to us. [REDACTED] seemed confident that [REDACTED] would call if he felt he had such information. [REDACTED] does not know how to reach [REDACTED] now but expects to hear from him within the next two or three weeks.

4. [REDACTED] is "semi-retired" and living in [REDACTED] Connecticut. He said we could call him any time; he was "sitting on his patio looking out at the water." His telephone number is area code [REDACTED]. The WATS line is 485.
