Dear Mr. Kelly:

This is further to our 16 February 2000 final response to your 6 February 1995 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for records described as "the CIA's investigation [into] MKULTRA - Program To Identify Subjects of Agency-Sponsored Drug Testing [carried out during] summer of 1978."

We became aware of an error in our initial review of the Victims Task Force documents. Specifically, with regard to the four documents hand-numbered 19, 73, 74, and 75, we mistakenly redacted the addresses of DEA/CIA safehouses that were eligible for release. Corrected copies of these four documents are enclosed. We are also sending you a list of the 66 documents which we located during our search but which we had to deny in their entirety.

We trust that this additional information will prove useful.
