THE NINE MOST IMPORTANT BOOKS ON THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT J.F. KENNEDY

1. OSWALD, ASSASSIN OR FALL GUY, Joachim Joesten, Marzani and Munsell, NY 1964. The first book, by an expert investigator who knew the Warren Report had to be a cover-up. This introduces the patsies, the decoys, and how facts are turned around from the beginning. Joesten, a victim of Nazism, recognized the parallels from the methods.
2. RUSH TO JUDGEMENT, Mark Lane, Holt, Rinehart and Winston, NY, 1966. Mark Lane analyzed the bullets, weapons, direction of the shots, the witnesses, and made the Grassy Knoll famous forever for deceptions. The President was assassinated. The cover-up was torturous for many.
3. FORGIVE MY GRIEF, VOLUMES I, II, III, IV. Penn Jones, Jr. Midlothian, Texas, 1965, 1967, 1969, 1974. I count these four volumes as ONE BOOK. Penn Jones' insight into the untimely, strange, violent deaths of primary witnesses to the murders of JFK, Officer Tippit, Lee H. Oswald and Jack Ruby illustrated the desperation to cover-up these murders. The pattern of continuous witness killing has escalated today.
4. DOCUMENT ADDENDUM TO THE WARREN REPORT, David Lifton, Sighttext Publications, Calif. 1968. David Lifton reported the Warren Commission members meetings from Dec. 5, 1963 to Sept. 18, 1964. In their own words their criminality, ignorance, and mechanics for violating the oath to "tell the truth" can be studied for years to come.
5. FAREWELL AMERICA, James Hepburn, Frontiers, Canada, 1968. The authors were a compilation of intelligence agents working for Charles DeGaulle. Their inquiries led to the Kennedy assassins. This book tells how and why murders took place. It crosses boundaries from USA to Europe, and shows the larger economic motives.
6. WHO'S WHO IN THE CIA, Julius Mader, Berlin, Germany. 1968. After four years of researching the Warren Commission Hearings, specific names of people with Lee and Marina Oswald were obvious agents. Who's Who listed them. Dr. Rudolf A. Winnacker, German, Pentagon, responsible for writing Warren Report. John McVickar, Richard Snyder, Jack Crichton, Bill Moyers and others.
7. NOMENCLATURE OF AN ASSASSINATION CABAL, William Torbitt. Private publication, available, RESEARCH, PO Box 1107, Aptos, Calif. 95003. NASA and the Nazis, Division V of FBI, Defense Intelligence Security Command, DISC, Mafia, and White Russian Solidarists. This document blends these five groups into the assassination team. The national and international cooperation of Murder, Inc.
8. ASSASSINATION OF JFK BY COINCIDENCE OR CONSPIRACY? Bernard Fensterwald, Zebra Books, NY, 1977. Biographical material on persons involved in these maneuvers, with pictures. Valuable material to study as individuals within the larger Odessa network.
9. THE KENNEDY CONSPIRACY, AN UNCOMMISSIONED REPORT ON THE JIM GARRISON INVESTIGATION, Paris Flammonde, Meredith Press, 1969. A fine book on the efforts of New Orleans District Atty. Jim Garrison's case against Clay Shaw. Monumental, and very valuable.

HOW THE CIA PLANNED TO SILENCE CRITICS OF THE WARREN REPORT AND THE WARREN COMMISSION MEMBERS.

CIA DOCUMENT NUMBER 1035 - 960. Freedom of Information Act, Review Sept.1976

Subject: Countering Criticism of the Warren Report.

PSYCH

1. Our concern:

Speculation since day JFK was killed, who was responsible. Warren Commission report stemmed for a time the questions. Various writers now have had time to scan the documents, report. New wave of books and articles criticizing the Commission findings. Critics speculate there was some kind of conspiracy. They often imply the Commission itself was involved.

Chief Justice Earl Warren. Sen. Sherman Cooper, Ky.
Rep. Gerald Ford, R. Mich. John J. McCloy (Nazis, Chase, I.G. Farben)
Rep. Hale Boggs, D. La. Sen. R. Russell, D. Ga.

Allen Dulles, OSS, CIA, fired by JFK after Bay of Pigs, didn't trust.
Recent poll, 46% USA, don't think Oswald alone, more adverse abroad.

2. This trend of opinion is a matter of concern to US Govt. and CIA. Members of Commission chosen for integrity, experience, prominence. Efforts to impugn their rectitude and wisdom casts doubt on the WHOLE LEADERSHIP of AMERICAN SOCIETY.

A tendency to hint President Johnson some way responsible. Such innuendo will injure the reputation of the American Government. Our CIA involved, we assisted the Commission, the investigation. Conspiracy theories throw suspicion on our organization. The aim of this CIA dispatch is to provide material for countering and discrediting conspiracy theorists, stop circulation abroad.

3. Action:

- a. Discuss with politicians, editors, how thorough Warren Comm. was. Point out that conspiracy talk is deliberately generated by Communist propagandists.
- b. Employ (CIA) propaganda assets to answer and refute attacks. Book reviews, feature articles. "Our play" should say "critics wedded to theories before evidence was in, politically interested (we might run for office), financially interested."
Mark Lane more difficult to answer as a whole, lost in unrelated details.

4. FOLLOWING ARGUMENTS useful, for Media, in private, attack publications:

- a. No significant new evidence. No agreement among critics. Compare to Reichstag fire, 1933, Loner, Communists, Nazis, various views.
- b. Critics overvalue particular items. Use eyewitnesses, ignore ballistics, autopsy, and photographic evidence.
- c. Large scale conspiracy would be impossible to conceal. Atty. Gen. Robert Kennedy would not overlook or conceal conspiracy. "Gerald Ford would hardly have held his tongue"
A conspirator would never choose such a location.
- e. Oswald would not have been any sensible person's choice for a conspirator. He was a "loner", questionable reliability, an unknown quantity to any professional intelligence service"
- d. Critics often enticed by intellectual pride. They light on some theory and fall in love with it. They scoff at the Commission, it did not always answer questions.
- f. Charges the Commission a rush job. It was 3 mos. after deadline. Pressure to speed it up, irresponsible speculation delayed.
SOME OF SAME CRITICS, REFUSING TO ADMIT THEIR ERRORS, still critics.
