1. By their own admission, AGS's genetic bacteria could "affect people with weak immune systems, infections from cancer, or other sick individuals". Steven Cull, Monterey Herald, who chose test site.
2. ADVANCED GENETIC SCIENCE INC. got the permit within a month for tests that usually take "9 mos. to a year" and were assured secrecy by EPA.
3. The nature of the substance, being unknown, requires extreme caution, secrecy, protective clothing, and destruction of all pieces except for what is taken to the lab. in Berkeley.
